I've had a chance to look over the document and figure that you e-mailed. I think we're pretty much good to go. Although I have one comment regarding a statement in the 1st paragraph towards the bottom. The sentence reads, "*Likewise, no perennial or intermittent streams are present within the proposed IBC mining area...*". I'm confused. The development of panel #20 undermines the Right Fork of Grassy Trail which is characterized as intermittent by the MRP (See page 7-11). Please address.
