Good morning,

The Division received the above-noted application on 8/14/2018. After a closer review of the amendment, it's been determined that it does not meet the minimum requirements to proceed to formal technical review.

In order to revise the surface drainage plan, the amendment must contain the requisite supporting calculations that demonstrate that the diversion is adequately sized to safely handle the design storm event. The Division can't sign off on the drainage plan revision without them.

Please re-submit the amendment with the revised drainage map (Plate 7-2), supporting calculations along with the appropriate design drawings that show how the new culvert will be installed (i.e. inlet/outlet details, grades etc.). The drawings are necessary for inspection purposes.
