2. Signs and Markers

I inspected the signs and markers at the site. The information is correct and meets the requirement of the R645 Coal Rules.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

Diversions were inspected and functioning as designed.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

Sediment ponds were inspected. Ponds contained some water but were not discharging during the inspection. Discharging of water is unlikely. No hazardous conditions were noticed. The embankments appeared to be stable.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

The refuse pile embankments were stable. No water was impounding on the refuse pile. Water flows off the refuse pile through a culvert and enters into a sediment pond.

8. Noncoal Waste

The site was clear of non-coal waste materials.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

Roads to and from the refuse pile are graded and maintained. The diversions were open and functioning as designed.
