## **2. Signs and Markers**

The mine identification sign is posted at the entrance into the permit area along the left side of the county road looking up-canyon. The identification signs meet the minimum requirements of the R645 Coal Rules.

### **4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions**

The diversions were inspected and were functioning as design. The site has received quite a bit of rainfall the past two weeks.

### **4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments**

All sediment ponds had water in them. None of the sediment pond were discharging during the inspection.

## **7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments**

The refuse pile was idle and no mining was occurring. The pile appears to be stable. No hazardous were notice during the inspection.

## **8. Noncoal Waste**

The site was clear of non coal waste materials.

### **16.b Roads: Drainage Controls**

Road drainage controls were performing as designed. The diversions were open and functioning.
