3. Topsoil

A retention berm has been placed around the base of the east pile on three sides; the east side berm still needs to be installed. The topsoil piles have supposedly been seeded. Ms. Gina Rau, Environmental Manager, provided information to the Division regarding the application rate and the species involved with the mix. on May 20, 2009. The surveyed acreage of both of the COVOL topsoil piles amounts to 0.2 acres. 5.54 PLS were applied to the two piles.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

The east side pond was dry; the west pond had a damp bottom. The west pond inlet ditch retained water.

4.c Hydrologic Balance: Other Sediment Control Measures

There is a pile of dirt mixed with carbonaceous material in storage along the west side perimeter fence. The pile does not have any sediment retention about it. The Permit applicant was asked to return the pile to its original location, or install some type of treatment to prevent sediment laden runoff from reporting off the proposed permit boundary. Mr. Edwards agreed to implement one treatment or the other.

4.d Hydrologic Balance: Water Monitoring

There was no visible flow occurring in either disturbed or undisturbed area diversions.

20. Air Quality Permit

The Permit Applicant's water truck was operating during today's inspection.

21. Bonding and Insurance

The Division notified the Permit Applicant on April 21, 2009 that the letter-of-credit provider (J.P. Morgan Chase, N.A.) supporting the \$ 165,000 amount for reclamation purposes of the COVOL site would not automatically extend for any additional periods the LOC and same would expire on August 31, 2009. The Permit Applicant must post adequate bond coverage by July 31, 2009 or LOC #CTCS-679537 will be forfeited to the DOGM / OSM..
