2. Signs and Markers

The Permittee has installed decals on the Permittee Identification signs posted outside the main gate and on the administration building which provide the DOGM permit number. The name of the Company, the mailing address and the contact telephone number for this site have been in place since the Permittee started operation at this site.

3. Topsoil

The Permittee informed the Division that the berms around the base of the two topsoil piles are scheduled to be redefined in order to provide more freeboard. Also, the Permittee plan to re-seed the piles before winter snows fall, to take advantage of that moisture. The Division suggested that the piles be roughened at the same time as the berm redefining process, in order to enhance the moisture retention capability of the resource. To the untrained eye, the material in the topsoil piles appears to be almost the same as Mancos shale.

4.c Hydrologic Balance: Other Sediment Control Measures

The silt fence on the SW side of the west side topsoil pile appeared capable of functioning as designed.

4.d Hydrologic Balance: Water Monitoring

None of the diversions at the site were flowing.

20. Air Quality Permit

A front end loader was spreading feed material on one of the operational pads for the purpose of allowing it to dry. There was no wind during today's inspection. Only a minute amount of dust was coming off the material. There were no trucks accessing the property during today's inspection. The undisturbed areas outside of the permit area fence were observed for the presence of wind borne coal fines. No significant accumulations were observed. There is some graying of the surface soils on the east side.
