The identification signs meet the R645 Coal Rule requirements. The information complies with Chapter 1 in the MRP.

The topsoil piles were inspected and there were no signs of wind or water erosion. The topsoil piles were stable and protected by a berm.

**4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions**

The diversions and culverts were spot-check and were open and functioning as design. No water was flowing within the structures during the inspection.

**4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments**

I inspected the two sediment ponds. The ponds were not discharging. I did not see any hazardous conditions to the sediment ponds. The sediment ponds are incised. The embankments were stable.
