2. Signs and Markers

The identification was reviewed with the information in the MRP. The sign has the correct information as noted in the MRP. The identification information meets with the requirements in the R645 Coal Rules.

3. Topsoil

I inspected the topsoil piles and did not see any signs of wind or water erosion.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

I inspected the diversions and they were functioning as designed. No water was flowing within the diversions. All culverts were open.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

I inspected the sediment ponds. The ponds were not discharging and no water was flowing into the sediment ponds. I did not see any hazardous conditions. The permittee conducted a 4th quarter sediment pond inspection on November 25, 2014. This inspection was P.E. certified.

4.d Hydrologic Balance: Water Monitoring

Water monitoring results are submitted to the Division on a quarterly bases. The information is review by the staff in Salt Lake City.

4.e Hydrologic Balance: Effluent Limitations

There was no discharge for the 4th quarter of 2014.

7. Coal Mine Waste, Refuse Piles, Impoundments

There is a concern of material that is already processed through the facility / clean. This material could be considered refuse material. If this is waste material it cannot exceed 1500 tons.

8. Noncoal Waste

The site was free of non-coal waste materials.

All roads are primary roads.

There have been no new support facilities added to the mining operation since the last inspection.
