### Reviewer Comments

3/13/2017, PB. The MRP states that coal that is cleaned in the permit area is only temporarily stored at the facility (p. 5-16) and that coal that remains on site after 30 days will be sampled (p. 7-14). During an on site visit on February 8, 2017, it was apparent that two large stockpiles in the South coal stockpile area had been on site longer than 30 days. These stockpiles, one high ash coarse and one high ash fines, must be sampled in accordance with the MRP commitment provided in Section 7.3.1.3. on p. 7-14.
