2. Signs and Markers

The identification sign was inspected and it meets the requirements of the R645 Coal Rules. See Photo

3. Topsoil

The topsoil piles were snow covered. It is unlikely that wind or water erosion has occurred.

4.a Hydrologic Balance: Diversions

Diversions were filled with sediment in past inspections. I assume this has not changed since no one is working at Wellington Dry Coal. The gates are locked. Notice of Violation and FTA Cessation Orders have been written.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

Sediment ponds are incised. It is unlikely that a hazardous condition exist. Ponds most likely contain a small amount of water. I cannot see due to gates are locked and the fence line is lower elevation than sediment ponds. The last sediment pond inspection that I inspected was first quarter of 2018.

8. Noncoal Waste

There is a small amount of non-coal waste on site.
