
Dear Ms. Burton:

The Division has reviewed your request for an extension of NOV 21201. Because no one at BRC received the Informal Conference Order upholding this violation until April 30, I am extending the time to abate until July 30, 2018.

Please be diligent in pursuing this abatement. There will be no further extensions of time to complete the required actions. If the NOV is not completely abated by the new deadline of July 30, 2018 the Division will be forced to write a Failure to Abate Cessation Order, which includes a fine of \$750/day retro-actively assessed to the date the violation was written and which may extend until the problem is abated, but at a minimum would be assessed for \$22,500.
