Dear Mr. Coward:

In light of the passage of time since the Division approved the permit application for the Kinney #2 Mine we would like to clarify the procedure for moving forward. Once Wasatch Natural Resources is prepared to post a bond and start construction the following will need to take place before the permit may be issued.

1. The Division will review the permit for outdated information and require updates to such. This should include any updates to baseline data that have been collected or would need to be collected during the application period and just prior to permit issuance. This may also include updates to wildlife or vegetation surveys or other monitoring or mitigation requirements.
2. Wasatch Natural Resources must post the bond amount in full. The bond calculations will need to be reviewed to ensure that they are still valid and perhaps escalated if needed.
3. The approved permit application, once updated, will undergo the statutory publication and public comment requirements. This may also involve holding an informal hearing if requested and having to address possible issues raised during that hearing.

Because of the required updates and repeat of the public comment period, it would be possible, and simpler for the permit to be issued in the name of Wasatch Natural Resources and avoid the necessity of further work to transfer the permit. Of course a revised Ownership and Control section (Chapter 1) would need to be submitted with the application.

The Division will not reanalyze the information that has already been approved, other than to ensure that necessary updates are provided. Permit issuance would not take considerably longer than it would if you were to post a bond today.
