I realized that I may have been a bit vague in when I requested "high producing" springs to be added to your proposal for the field reconnaissance. As you may recall, these would be the springs/seeps that did not have a water right associated with them but still deemed important to monitor. Generally, I would consider a productive spring to be one that consistently flows either in spring or fall, or both even if the flow is around 1 gal/min. Of course, if all the little seeps produce at least one gallon per minute, then we may want to reconsider upping that flow criteria.
