
It is our pleasure to inform you that we have signed a lease agreement with Coal Energy Group 3, LLC, a Nevada limited liability company, owned by Bob Nead, to operate our Kinney #2 Coal Mine near Scofield Utah. Of course, and as you are aware, and likely remember, the Kinney#2 RMP was completed and approved 30 June 2011. With the passage of more than five years, the permit will require a revision. Having anticipated revising the RMP, we have continuously monitored ground and surface water at the mine site without interruption, and over the past year have reinstated "baseline parameters" in our analysis suite with SGS.

We write to authorize Coal Energy to take over the permitting process at the Kinney#2 Mine and apply for a permit revision in the name of Coal Energy. Our agreement with Coal Energy requires it to proceed directly and diligently with the permit revision. Carbon Resources will be monitoring progress of the revision by making inquiries of UDOGM personnel and checking facts on the ground. Should Coal Energy breach our lease agreement by failing to proceed with permitting as committed, Carbon Resources reserves the right to withdraw the permissions granted in this letter and take over and assume the permitting process in the name of Carbon Resources.

We look forward to many discussions with you and your staff as this transition proceeds.
