Hi Larry,

It was good to see you this morning. I just wanted to send you a follow-up to our conversation regarding the deterrence cones for hawk nest #1541. As we discussed, whether you have broken ground or not, the cones need to be out of the nest before March 1, 2020.

If you have already broken ground by that point, and you have taken down the cones, then you're good to go.

If you have not already broken ground by that time, the cones still need come down and you would not be able to break ground until after August 31, 2020, barring additional consultations with the Fish and Wildlife Service.
