Dear Mr. Sikes:

On November 5, 1978, the Executive Secretary published notice of intent to approve construction of a coal preparation plant at Dog Valley Mine, Emery County, Utah, in the Salt Lake Tribune. The thirty-day public comment period has concluded; no comments were received.

This approval order authorizes construction of the coal preparation plant and air pollution control facilities. Conditions of the approval order are that the plant be constructed according to the plans and specifications submitted to our office, and that it be operated and maintained properly, in controlling fugitive particulate emissions, as described in the submitted plans.

Please advise us of the approximate date when you expect the plant to become operational, and contact us when it becomes operational, as a final inspection is required.
