Mary Boucek and Pamela Grubaugh-Littig met with Don Nelson on September 17, 1984 to discuss the status of the J. B. King Mine. Mr. Nelson stated that there are two prospective buyers for the mine and should know by September 24, 1984 if these prospects will materialize. Western States will then notify the Division of how they will proceed with permitting.

Mr. Nelson was advised that the reclamation plan must be approved if the mine is not purchased and Western States wishes to reclaim. He was also advised of the liability period (which should already be in the Mining and Reclamation Plan).

The question of how State Lands will want the portals sealed (or not) is a matter for administrative decision if that is the path chosen by the company.
