

Enclosed is a final modification to NOV #1 of 2, #N84-2-18-2 extending the abatement deadline until December 4, 1984, the 90th day and final day allowed for abatement under UCA 40-10-22 (c). Your latest submittal, dated November 9, 1984, was complete but indicated that the roadside drainage ditch is not sized adequately to meet the 10 year, 24 hour design requirements while providing a .3 foot freeboard. Inadequate runoff control measures up to the roadside drainage ditch were detected during an inspection by Dave Hooper, Hydrologist, Tom Wright and myself on November 8, 1984. Dave Hooper and Tom Wright will discuss problems with the existing drainage control measures with Gus Manwaring soon to allow time necessary to implement the required changes on the ground. As the December 4, 1984 deadline approaches please let me know of your progress.

I have enclosed a Termination Notice for NOV #2 of 2 effective November 9, 1984, because there are no outstanding problems with the southwest diversion or refuse ditch at this time and the culverts are clear.
