Thank you for the time you and Tom spent with me Tuesday to help bring me up to speed on the J.B. King Reclamation Project.

The following is the scope of work I plan for the first week in May, weather permitting.

Main Channel

I will use the design characteristics specified by T. Manson in his memo to File December 8, 1986, for the area 8 + 00 to 5 + 30.

Feeder Channel

I will use the design specifications developed at our meeting Tuesday. Specifically a V channel 1.5 feet deep and 6 feet wide at the top, with a 9" filter blanket of -2" material and a riprap layer of the following size distribution.

D100	13.75
D 85	12.00
D 50	11.00
D 20	5.5
D 10	3.6

Every effort will be made to utilize angular riprap. The area to be repaired is from station 5 + 30 on the main channel to 4 + 00 on the feeder channel.

Rill Development Repair

All rills in excess of 9" will be hand repaired and reseeded. The Contour furrows will be repaired.

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
Reseeding
