Memo from Brent Stettler to John Whitehead, regarding October 1987, vegetation survey assessment. Revegetation monitoring required for woody plant densities during first, third and fifth year following initiation of reclamation, and general vegetation monitoring during the first growing season was required for specific compository frequency and plant density. (Both monitored in 1987 second growing season). Vegetation report prepared by Reclamation Projects, Inc.
