The extended period of responsibility begins after the last year of work as stated in the Utah Coal Rules, R614-301-357.100. A contractor with a backhoe was observed during an inspection of the J. B. King site on November 7, 1991. A map is attached that outlines the affected area as being reclaimed in November 1991.

Please amend the permit to show this area with a bond clock setback. Reclamation efforts of this magnitude require a demonstration of performance through a minimum 10-year liability period.
