4a. The feeder ditch and the main channel are experiencing severe erosion in areas. NOV # N91-32-6-1 references some of these areas. A plan submitted on September 15, 1992 addresses what the operator feels is necessary to abate this violation. It is currently being reviewed by the Division. A letter was sent to the operator on December 7, 1992 requesting additional information to abate violation N91-32-6-1.

4c. Sediment control devices on the property are rapidly falling into disrepair and are to be removed pending the outcome of the resolution of the permit stipulation. This issue is currently being reviewed by the Division and is subject to the resolution of Violation No. N91-35-6-1. The information submitted in response to N91-35-6-1 was considered adequate to abate the violation, but does not constitute a finding that the site is erosionally stable. The operator has proposed a plan to allow soils and vegetation to mature and prevent any other man made disturbances. The division will make survey of the site at the first available chance using the Erosion Condition Classification System.

13. It was noted on this inspection and previous inspections that the abundant weed growth seen early in the summer has died off leaving areas denuded of vegetation which looked lush and green earlier in the year.

21. All Bonds and Insurance are in place and current.

Pending Violations- Nos. N91-35-6-1, N91-35-7-1 and Stipulation reponse R614-301-742.113.
