

Annual Subsidence Monitoring

Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

This letter is to inform you that the annual subsidence monitoring report for Western States Minerals Corporation's (WSMC) J.B. King Mine will be delayed until weather conditions improve at the site. On December 16, 1993, WSMC's personnel completed a traverse of the existing subsidence markers on-site. Before the data could be checked for errors bad weather forced WSMC personnel to leave the area. Due to poor visibility and extremely windy conditions, several errors resulted in the survey data. On February 20 and February 22, 1993, WSMC personnel again tried to complete the subsidence survey only to be stopped again by poor weather.

WSMC proposes to postpone the subsidence survey until late Spring of 1993, and if possible, coordinate the survey with the removal of the silt fences on the property.
