4c. OTHER SEDIMENT CONTROL MEASURES

The silt fences on site have now been removed. The operator cut the fence near ground level for removal.

9. PROTECTION OF FISH, WILDLIFE AND RELATED ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES

A noticeable increase in the numbers of ant hills have been noted on site. The possibility exist that at some point they may have to be controlled. The ant colonies denude an approximate 3 foot radius around the hill.

ATV tracks were noted all over the site.

13. REVEGETATION

No observable improvement was noted in the vegetation density or cover on areas previously identified as being deficient (i.e. face of refuse pile, and reseeded road area).

14. SUBSIDENCE CONTROL

The area of previous subsidence was walked, no additional or enlargement of cracks was noted.
