RE: Reclamation Plan Summary, J.B. King Mine, Western States Minerals Corporation, ACT/015/002, File #2, Emery County, Utah

SYNOPSIS

The permittee has submitted (received November 26, 1994) a summary of the 1994 Reclamation Plan. The text and map submitted will be inserted into the J.B. King Mine Mining and Reclamation Plan. The summary includes soils data, refuse data and approval letters from the Environmental Protection Agency Region VIII and the Utah Water Quality Board for the application of biosolids.

The information provided is suitable for insertion into the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP). However, when on-the-ground work is completed revisions to the MRP will be required.

ANALYSIS

Certain portions of the MRP will require alteration when the actual field work is completed. These alterations may include but not be limited to the following: the rate and location of biosolid application; volume, depth and location of rock mulch application; seed source and application rate.

The permittee must submit the complete data sets generated from the sampling and laboratory analysis of the refuse and soils (see Drawing No.:JBK-3 Drill Holes No. 1-11). In addition, the analyses of the biosolids from the Price River Improvement District must be submitted for insertion into the plan. This would include metals, Carbon:Nitrogen and nutrient analyses.

RECOMMENDATION

The information provided by the permittee is suitable for insertion into the Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP). However, when on-the-ground work is completed revisions to the MRP will be required.
