Dear Mr. Gerick:


The Division has reviewed the most recently submitted reconfiguration/reclamation plan for the J.B. King Mine, see attached technical memos.

The Division finds the proposed reconfiguration/reclamation plan adequate to approve interim abatement measures required by violations N91-32-6-1, N93-25-3-1 and N93-25-5-1. However, particular issues, enumerated in the attached memos, must be adequately addressed and on-the-ground implementation accomplished prior to the termination of the aforementioned violations. The abatement date for the violations has been extended to no later than 5:00 p.m. on May 19, 1994 (see attached modification).

The Division recommends that the soil/sludge/rock mulch sampling and analysis plan proceed as specified in the proposed reconfiguration/reclamation plan. Discussions with regard to laboratory results and their reclamation implication must be completed at the earliest possible date to allow ample time for implementation of the reconfiguration/reclamation plan.
