

Dear Pam:

Please accept this letter with attachments, as our request for renewal of the Reclamation Plan Permit at the J.B. King Reclaimed Minesite. The following attachments are included for your review, files, and approval:

1. Certificate of liability insurance coverage between April 1, 1995 and April 1, 1996 - This document was sent to you earlier, however, I have included another copy for your files.
2. Performance bond with Seaboard Surety Company for \$126, 078.00 - This bond was put into effect on August 13, 1985 and remains in effect until DOGM determines that the reclaimed lands at the J.B. King site satisfactorily meet the standards set forth in the approved Reclamation Plan (including the approved amendments to the same), and accordingly releases WSMC of its present reclamation responsibility.
3. A copy of the proposed "Public Notice For Permit Renewal" - This proposed advertisement will be published at least once weekly, for four consecutive weeks in the Emery County Progress newspaper as soon as I receive notification from you that the Ad is adequate and that the publication timing is appropriate.

PUBLIC NOTICE FOR PERMIT RENEWAL

Western States Minerals Corporation, 4975 Van Gordon Street, Wheat Ridge, Colorado 80033, has filed an application for renewal of its Reclamation Plan Permit for the J.B. King Reclaimed Minesite. The site is located approximately ten miles south of Emery, Utah and four miles east of Fremont junction (intersection of State Highway 10 and Interstate 70). The permit area is described as follows:

Approximately 30 acres located in Township 23 south, Range 6 east, SLBM, Utah;
Section 32 - a portion of S1/2 NW1/4, and a portion of N1/2SW1/4

The site is also shown on the "Walker Flat, Utah", USGS 7.5 minute quadrangle map as the Dog Valley Mine.

The project was permanently reclaimed in 1985, and was granted a Phase I bond release in 1986.

The renewal application was filed with the appropriate agency, and this notice is being published to comply with the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977, and State and Federal regulations promulgated pursuant to said Act.
