The reclamation only permit was renewed August 13, 1995 and will expire August 13, 2000. The bond amount specified in the permit is \$126,078.

2. SIGNS AND MARKERS

Signs and markers were in place. The permit entry sign was visible upon entry to the site.

4. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE

a. Diversions - No flows were noted in any of the new diversions.

b. Sediment Ponds and Impoundments - The sediment pond was dry. Jim Blackburn, operators representative, inspected the pond first quarter, 1996 and certified no obvious problems with the pond.

13. REVEGETATION

The site was very dry, a light rain had occurred the previous week.
