The reclamation only permit was renewed August 13, 1995 and will expire August 13, 2000. The bond amount specified in the permit is \$126,078.

The fence had been fixed where cut. Mr. Blackburn reported that two cows were inside the disturbed area before he repaired the fence. T-posts were placed over the vehicle tracks to prevent access.
