Dear Mr. Shaver:

As you may know certain information provided to the Division in a Notice of Intent to Commence Mining Operations (MR 1) and its attachments may be protected as confidential if so marked. Section 40-8-13 (2) of the Mined Land Reclamation Act states that information relating to the location, size, or nature of the mineral deposit marked confidential by the operator shall be protected as confidential information by the Board and the Division.

In your previously filed notice, no such designation was made. Possibly you were aware of this provision for confidentiality and perhaps not, now however, we would like your wishes known as we have had certain public requests to examine all or parts of the files.
