Swisher Coal Company, Huntington #4 and Gordon Creek #2) *Rentl - Hill*

ACT 1015/004 in Swish 23

A meeting was held on the morning of 12 January, 1979 between Dan Guy of Swisher Coal Company, Mike Thompson and Larry Suchoski of Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, and Larry Damrau of OSM. The major item of discussion was the draft additional information needed for federal approval of the proposed Huntington #4 mining and reclamation plan. The material was dated January 5, 1979. *AS*

Although Mr. Guy believed that certain aspects requested had been addressed in the previously submitted plan, he stated that he would address each aspect as requested. He stated that presently he hopes to have the requested information completed and submitted by the end of February, 1979.

It was also brought to Mr. Guy's attention that investigation into the Citizens Complaint, issued by Mr. Movell Jewkes against Swisher Coal Company, Gordon Creek #2 Mine, had been initiated. he was informed that a future on-site meeting is planned to be conducted and that he would be notified as to the exact time and date. Mr. Thompson proposed that monitoring any water in the underground mine within the area of Jewkes spring may prove useful in the future. Mr. Guy stated that although there was little water, to his knowledge, he would look into obtaining information on location of seeps and flow amount if there proved to be any within the vicinity of the Jewkes property in question.
