RE: Huntington Canyon #4
Beaver Creek Coal Co.
ACT/015/004
Emery County, Utah

The above-mentioned mine operation was inspected on August 25, 1981, by Rex Fidler and Sandy Pruitt, accompanied by Jim Voorhees. The purpose of the inspection was to determine the mine compliance status in regard to the requirements with an August 16, 1981, deadline in a registered letter to David Meyer dated July 21, 1981.

All of the requirements had been addressed to some extent.

1. Noncoal waste had been removed from most of the mine area. A small pile of reuseable scrap metal is stored in a portion of the operation. The operator is advised that this storage site could be regarded as a waste pile by employees and the trash problem may be regenerated.
2. Timbers stored outside of the disturbed area have been relocated underground.
3. Coal spillage had been cleaned up but it could not be determined if the cause of the coal stockpile spillage had been determined and measures taken to prevent a reoccurrence.
4. The gully along the pipeline adjacent to the sediment pond inlet had been filled in but not stabilized. At the time of this inspection, a gully had formed again. A berm should be employed along the office pad perimeter above this area to divert runoff away from the fill to the sediment pond inlet.
5. The inlet to the sediment pond had been adequately stabilized with more riprap material.
6. The runoff controls (i.e., surface grade, conveyance ditches and culverts) were well maintained and functional.
7. No spill prevention measures have been employed for the diesel storage tanks at the middle pad but were adequately placed around the tanks on the upper pad.
