Subject: Beaver Creek Coal Company, Huntington Canyon No. 4
Mine, Emery County, Utah, Underground Mining and
Reclamation Plan

The revised Section 9 - Vegetation Resources and the final Section 10 - Fish and Wildlife Resources to the subject plan which were transmitted to this office with your form letters dated April 20, 1982, have been reviewed as requested for completeness and technical adequacy relating to the responsibilities of the Minerals Management Service (MMS). We have determined that these two documents are compatible with the requirements of the 30 CFR 211 regulations and for our administration of the associated Federal coal leases. Maximum Economic Recovery will not be affected as determined by our final review of the complete plan in December of 1981. Our final review letter dated December 23, 1981, listed four stipulations to become a part of the plan approval.
