An on-site inspection of drillsites was conducted July 27, 1982, by Steve Falk of MMS, Sid Volgelpohl of the Price BLM office, and Everett Hooper and Tammy Balkenbush from DOGM. Kaiser representatives were Robert Turner of Kaiser Steel and Dave Novak of the Royal Land Company.

Possibly two drillsites, numbers 19 and 21, in the exploration program are on State land. The first site inspected (#21) could be either on State or Federal land when it is surveyed in. This site is right off the BLM Horse Canyon Road. Very little, if any, grading will be required to move the drill rig in. Two small mud pits will be constructed using a back hoe.

Drillsite #19 is located adjacent to Williams Wash on State land. This site will be accessed by an existing road. No grading will be required here. Two pits will also be dug at this site far enough away from the Wash to prevent seepage into the wash.

Approval of the plan is expected without delay.
