RE: Notification of Diesel Spill

A phone call on March 28, 1983 from Scott Raymond of Beaver Creek Coal Company notified Jim Smith of the Division about a diesel fuel spill which occurred at the Huntington #4 Mine during the late afternoon of March 24, 1983. Approximately 300 gallons of diesel fuel spilled onto the upper pad during an attempt to move the storage tank. Existing berms and the addition of straw bales appeared to contain the spilled material. Rock dust was applied to soak up the excess material on the ground, which was then scooped up with a front end loader and placed into a dumpster for removal from the premises. The spill was adequately contained and the situation has now been rectified.
