Subject: Beaver Creek Coal Company, Huntington Canyon No. 4 Mine
Emery County, Utah, Permit Application Package (PAP)

Mr. Vance reported the mine has been closed and that the portals were sealed as per the unapproved subject PAP. Copies of the following pages from the subject PAP are attached:

1 copy each - page 3-24, 3-56, 3-56a, 3-57, 3-69, and 3-71.

Also attached is a copy of a letter dated December 23, 1981, Moffitt to Utah State Coordinator, OSM, Denver, which briefly shows the procedure required (stipulation No. 1) by the BLM. Actually the closing of this mine should have been handled as per the approved 30 CFR 211 mine plan since the subject PAP is still in the approval process.

Even though OSM has assumed leadership in covering the coal outcrop and sealing of the portals of the Beaver Creek No. 4 mine, BLM still has the primary responsibility to see that any remaining resource is adequately protected. In the reclamation process you should periodically visit the minesite to assure this is done.
