The maps and pages forwarded with the Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining letter dated October 15, 1984, and identified as "Response to stipulations, draft final technical analysis and decision package, Beaver Creek Coal Company, Huntington Canyon #4 Mine, Act/015/004, #2, Emery County, Utah" have been reviewed for conformance with the requirements of 43 CFR 3482.1(c) rules and regulations. The documents were also reviewed relative to the resource recovery and protection plan (R₂P₂) deficiencies referred to in our memoranda dated January 10, 1984, and September 19, 1984, to Utah Senior Project Manager, OSM, Denver.

The proposed coal recovery procedures will safely obtain maximum economic recovery of the coal resource within the plan area by following the planned technology and by using the types of equipment listed in the plan.

Within the limits of our authority we concur with the Huntington #4 Mine R₂P₂ plan as amended and on file in this office and recommend that it be included as an integral part of the subject PAP.
