The package of maps and pages forwarded with your letter dated March 26, 1984, and identified as "03/20/84 submittal of revisions for mining and reclamation plan in response to draft technical analysis" has been reviewed for completeness and technical adequacy with respect to the underground mining part of the subject PAP. The documents were also reviewed relative to the underground plan deficiencies noted in our memorandum dated January 10, 1984, to Utah Senior Project Manager, OSM, attention Louis Hamm.

The resource recovery and protection plan (R<sub>2</sub>P<sub>2</sub>) part of the above submittal is in conformance with the requirements of 43 CFR 3482.1(c). Our review did not identify any conflicts with the underground mining part of the subject PAP or future coal recovery within the plan area.

The draft technical analysis was prepared without considering concerns or deficiencies listed in our memorandum dated January 10, 1984, (referred to above).

We realize the Beaver Creek Coal Company is planning to close the Huntington Canyon No. 4 mine in the near future; however, since the subject PAP is to be processed, the BLM concerns will still be required.
