On December 20, 1984 Division of Oil, Gas and Mining, Mining Field Specialists, Ken Wyatt, and Tom Wright conducted a partial inspection of the Huntington #4 Mine. Dan Guy of Beaver Creek coal Company accompanied these inspectors. The weather was cold with heavy snow falling.

Access to the upper portal area could not be obtained due to the snow depth. According to Mr. Guy all equipment and structures have been removed with the exception of several trailers. Mr. Guy indicated that rock had been placed in the undisturbed diversion outlet as discussed during the previous inspection. The gate to the upper pad was obtained. No activity was occurring. According to Mr. Guy, December 20, 1984 will be the last day that the road will be open and accessible until next spring.

No problems were encountered.
