COMPLIANCE WITH PERMANANT PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

UMC 771 et al Permits

The interim program approval was granted by OSM on January 30, 1980. The state mining approval dated August 25, 1977 was granted under the Mined Land Reclamation Act.

UMC 817.11 Signs and Markers

The mine entrance sign was complete and perimeter markers were noted.

UMC 817.21 - .25 Topsoil

There were no topsoil problems at this time.

UMC 817.41 -.57 Hydrologic Balance

Certification for the sediment pond was available at the mine office, although design drawings were not field checked.

The pond has been recently cleaned at a cost of \$12,000. The capacity has greatly increased. Ditches have recently been cleaned as well and seem to be functioning.

UMC 817.52 Hydrologic Balance: Water Monitoring

The NPDES permit #UT-0023116 was available upon request. It is dated November 3, 1982, and has an expiration date of June 30, 1987. The receiving water is Mill Creek tributary to Huntington Creek.

No water monitoring problems were noted at this time.
