A partial inspection was conducted at the above mentioned mine site by Barton Kale of the Division on August 14, 1984. The inspector was accompanied by Ken Fleck of Beaver Creek Coal Company.

Due to mining out of this site, materials are being stored at any and all available pad areas. The materials stored are of varied nature but care must be taken for potential hazards. If problems are found with the disposal or storage of such materials as oil barrels and or lubricant cans, enforcement action could be warranted. The operator was informed and is aware of his responsibilities.

This site will probably remain active (according to the operator) until the Gordon Creek #7 area becomes operational. The fate of Huntington #4 area after that time has yet to be determined.
