

The above mentioned operation was given a partial inspection on December 21, 1983 by Joe Helfrich and Lorin Nielsen of The Department of Natural Resources. They were accompanied by Dan Guy of Beaver Creek Coal Company. The purpose of the inspection was twofold, initially to acquaint Mr. Nielsen with a typical example of steep slope coal mining in Utah and secondly the reclamation work done on the access road to the sediment pond. Due to the deep snow and cold weather conditions a brief tour of approximately twenty minutes was conducted. In view of the access road to the sediment pond, Mr. Guy indicated that after the pond had been cleaned out the road had been regraded. It could not be ascertained if the road had been seeded, as there was approximately two feet of snow covering the area effected by the construction of the access road.
