Pursuant to your phone conversation of January 24, 1984 with John Whitehead of the Division's staff, please find enclosed a copy of the Beaver Creek Coal Company, Huntington #4 Draft Technical Analysis (TA). Additionally for information's sake I've enclosed a copy of a December 20, 1983 letter which solicited comments on the Huntington #4 Mining and Reclamation Plan.

It is imperative that you forward any comments and concerns which you may have as soon as possible regarding mining activities at the Huntington #4 Mine which may be affecting municipal water supplies for Emery County. Within the next two weeks the Division will be finalizing the Technical Analysis for this mine and comments received after that time may not be able to be considered. Would you also please incorporate in your letter the cost estimates for rerouting and treating water should the mining activities intercept the municipal water supply to Little Bear Spring. Mr. Whitehead requested this information from Mr. Darrel Leemaster of the Castle Valley Special Services District on December 19, 1983 and also on January 9, 1984.
