RE: Reclamation Photographs Reviewed to Document Backfilling and Grading for Bond Release, Beaver Creek Coal Company, Huntington #4 Mine, INA/015/004, #5 and #14, Emery County, Utah

John J. Whitehead, Thomas Munson and myself reviewed the photographs of the backfilling and grading, channel restoration, and revegetation done at the Huntington #4 inactive mine site on January 28, 1986. John J. Whitehead and Thomas Munson documented the reclamation work at the mine site on October 2, 1985.

The concensus of the group from reviewing the photographs was that adequate backfilling and grading has been performed at the site to release 60 percent of the reclamation bond for \$216,062.00. A bond in the amount of \$144,042.00 will remain posted. This amount would be maintained to insure monitoring (hydrologic, vegetation and erosion), maintenance (revegetation) and removal of the sediment ponds will be done during the remaining bond liability period (until April 1995).
