Dear Dr. Nielson:

The Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE), Western Field Operations (WFO), has received the March 16, 1987, Beaver Creek Coal Company's submittal of an amendment to the approved mine reclamation plan of Utah permit No. ACT/015/004-86A for the Huntington #4 mine. This amendment proposes changes to the water monitoring plan. OSMRE reviewed this submittal and has determined that it does not constitute a modification to the approved mining plan under 30 CFR 746.18. Based on the review of the submittal, OSMRE concurs with the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining's (DOGM's) decision to approve the submittal as indicated in DOGM's letter dated March 23, 1987, and the Federal permit UT-004, dated April 1985, is revised accordingly.
