This letter is in response to the above-referenced Ten-Day Letter, certified copy received April 8, 1991.

Number 1 of 1 reads: "Failure to have adequate liability insurance coverage. Applies to entire mine site. There are five mines permitted to Beaver Creek in Utah. The policy is for two million dollars and covers all of Atlantic Richfield, including Beaver Creek." Regulation Cited: R614-301-890.100

Division Response: The Division received an updated Certificate of Insurance for Beaver Creek Coal Company dated April 2, 1991 (see attached). The excess liability has been increased to \$7,500,000, which meets the limits required. Coverage also includes use of explosive and damage to water wells.

The Division feels this issue was resolved before the TDL was issued and should be withdrawn.
