1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

The reclamation permit was issued April 30, 1995 and expires April 30, 2000. No stipulations were attached to the permit.

Written concurrence from OSM for the Phase III Bond Release was given. The Division granted Phase III bond release pending removal of all signs and markers. Phase III bond release is recommended.

2. SIGNS AND MARKERS:

Markers were removed from site.

9. PROTECTION OF FISH, WILDLIFE AND RELATED ENVIRONMENTAL VALUES

Three bull elk were observed on the reclaimed area. Heavy elk use was observed on the reclaimed area.

10. SLIDES AND OTHER DAMAGE

A rock fall was observed on the upper portion of the lower pad. Truck to smaller size rocks had fallen near the detention/splash basin. The area is well armored with rock and vegetated and no drainage problems should occur.

21. BONDING & INSURANCE

Liability insurance is held by Indemnity Insurance Company of North America. The amount of \$500,000 is in compliance with the regulations and is effective 1/1/96 to 1/1/99. The bond is in the amount of \$46,734 and is held by United Pacific Insurance. This bond rider reduction was effective 1/31/96.
