



Dear Mr Moffitt:

Atlantic Richfield Company requests permission to add two drill holes to our 1982 Wild Horse Ridge Exploration Program on Federal Leases U-020668 and U-38727. The proposed drill holes, WHR-7 and WHR-8 will be drilled approximately 900 feet in depth with a helicopter-accessed rig. In addition, all drill crews and supplies will be transported to and from the drill site with a helicopter. We propose to pump water through rubberized wire braid hose from a stock pond on the ridge top to the drill-site. The waterline will lie upon the ground, without the use of any trenches or structures, and will therefore cause minimal disturbance to the surface.

We intend to follow the same plan as has been delineated in our Drilling Permit Application of May 24, 1982 and in the stipulations cited in the partial approval of that program, August 16, 1982. We intend to meet all U.S. Forest Service standards in drill-site preparation, rehabilitation and erosion control, and to conduct our operation in a manner as to cause minimal impact on the environment.

We agree to fully comply with 30CFR 211-6 of the operating regulations regarding the reporting of all information obtained by this program. We request that all data be held confidential.


