On August 12, 1982, an on-site tour was conducted of the proposed road and pad area for the Wild Horse Ridge exploration project.

In attendance were Dave Chenoweth and Greg Squires of Anaconda Minerals, Everett Hooper and Cy Young from the Division.

The proposed methods of topsoil handling and importance of the area as a critical wildlife habitat area were the topics of discussion.

The conclusions reached were:

1. The proposed site for the access road was the best location to minimize expenses and disturbance.
2. Care should be taken to leave in place as many trees as possible to minimize the effect on wildlife habitat.
3. The proposed methods of topsoil removal could be implemented and still minimize the deterioration of topsoil quality.
