A partial inspection of this site was conducted on May 17, 1984, by Barton Kale and Tom Wright, Division Field Specialists. The purpose of this visit was to check the site for any activity. No one was available at the site.

No evidence of any recent mining activity was observed on the area.

The mine portals were sealed and sediment controls were in place. The berm around the lower end of the pad was in place and any drainage would be controlled by the sediment pond. At this time the pond was completely dry.

The topsoil pile is in place on the site with protection from runoff.

No problems were noted on this inspection.
